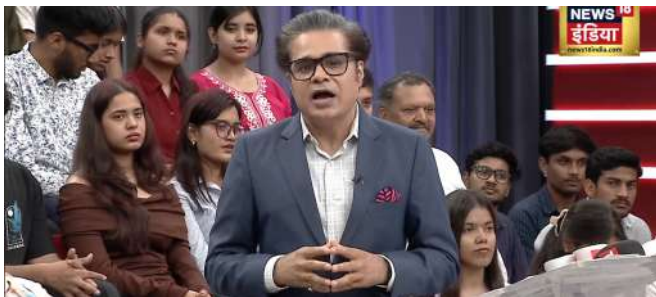


NEWS18 STUDIO VISIT



WITNESSING JOURNALISM IN ACTION

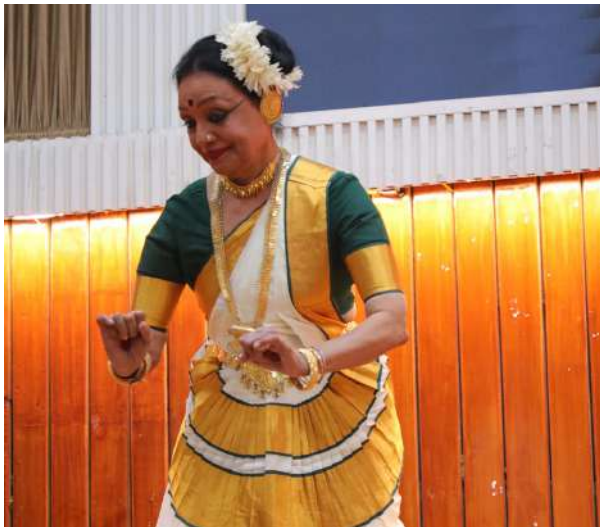

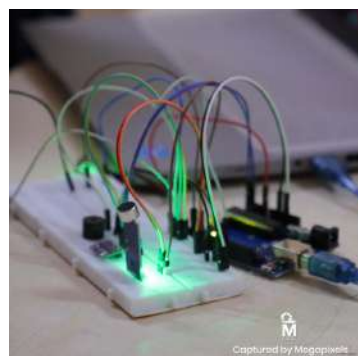
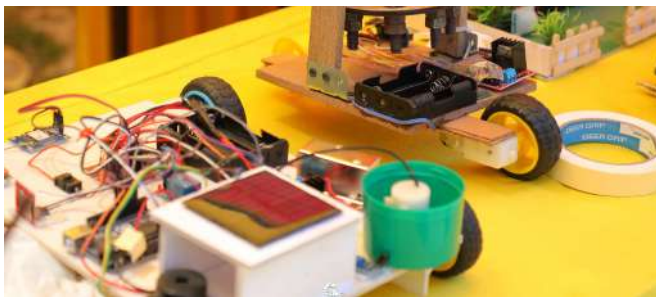


EBULLIENCE TECH FEST

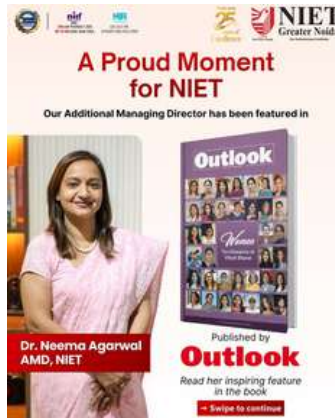
